**OFFERING THIS WEEK is for the Local Conference Advance.**

REVOLUTIONARY GENEROSITY demands that we change our perspective. We must gain a Kingdom vision of the nature of generosity. How does real generosity act, look, and feel in the context of our current reality? (1) When thinking of generosity, many people look at the size of the gift or the nobility of the cause. However, Jesus looks beyond the outward appearance and measures generosity by a radically new standard: the condition of the giver's heart. "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also," (Matt. 6:21). Stewardship is a matter of the heart, a matter of the soul. This goes deeper than the value of a dollar. It is a spiritual matter of emulating Him and it is interactive. A church group was kicked out of a park because of their interaction with the homeless. The police officer said, "You can't feed the homeless here; you need a permit!" The pastor replied, "We are not feeding the homeless, we are eating with them." This is the true heart of generosity, how it looks, acts, and feels (2). Often, generosity is about something we do for an individual or group instead of something we do with them (3).

Prayer: Dear Heavenly Father, on this Sabbath day we want to practice Revolutionary Generosity by giving not just our money but our hearts. Bless the loose offerings that will help our Conference to reach precious souls and bring them into your fold. In Jesus' name, AMEN!
