TRUST IN GOD (T5 of 7): "Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight" (Prov. 3:5-6 NIV).

THEOLOGY (T6 of 7): Biblical foundations and study of stewardship lifestyle principles. "We are God's stewards, entrusted by Him with time and opportunities, abilities and possessions, and the blessings of the earth and its resources. We are responsible to Him for their proper use. We acknowledge God's ownership by faithful service to Him and our fellow human beings, and by returning tithe and giving offerings for the proclamation of His gospel and the support and growth of His church. Stewardship is a privilege given to us by God for nurture in love and the victory over selfishness and covetousness. Stewards rejoice in the blessings that come to others as a result of their faithfulness" [SDA Fundamental Beliefs #21].

TESTIMONY (T7 of 7): The Bible says, "For if I preach the gospel, I have nothing to boast of, for necessity is laid upon me; yes, woe is me if I do not preach the gospel! ...I have been entrusted with a stewardship" (1 Cor. 9:16-17, NKJV). Verbalizing what God did, does, and will do (by faith) is not optional for a good steward. We are compelled to give our testimony.

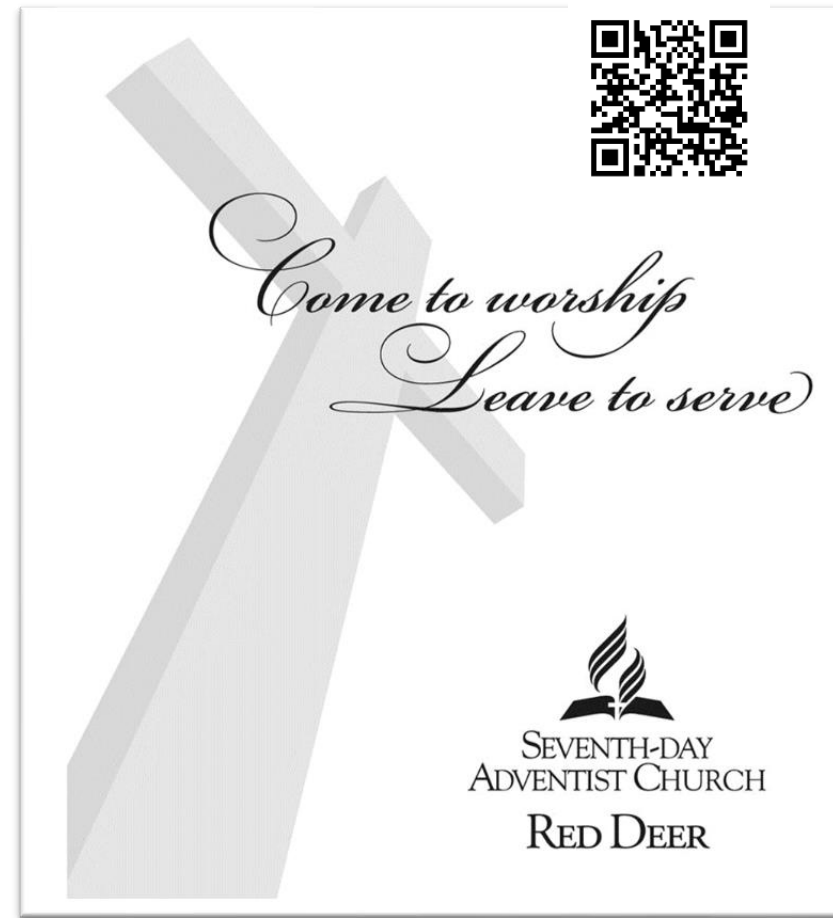
